John Morgan Schromen, age 73, of Orrville, went to be with the Lord on Monday, April 22, 2019, at his residence.

John was born on January 26, 1946, in Massillon, to the late John William and Mildred (Morgan) Schromen. He graduated from Orrville High School in 1964 where he was President of the Student Council and co-captain of the football team. John then earned a Bachelor's Degree from Capital University where he held a football and academic scholarship, and was listed in *Who's Who*. He served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War, stationed in Turkey. Following his service in the Army, John received a Doctorate in Law from The Ohio State University.

He worked as a prosecuting attorney in Troy, OH before moving back to Orrville where he was a private practice lawyer for many years.

John enjoyed praying, reading, walking, and following the Cleveland sports teams. He traveled extensively around the world. Although he never had his own children, John loved spending time with his family, and taking care of his mother. He will be remembered for his sense of humor and positive outlook on life.
